**MISSION STATEMENT**

**PURPOSE**

**GOALS**

1. *Collectively organize youth service providers' efforts in Cherry Hill*
  - a. *Develop a youth service directory*
  - b. *Develop a youth service information bank*
  - c. *Host bi-monthly youth service providers' roundtables*
  - d. *Include youth in the planning and implementation of the plan*
  - e. *Co-locate existing services to maximize output*
2. *Address the current and future needs of the community youth*
  - a. *Host quarterly community youth forums*
  - b. *Develop a youth services advisory board*
  - c. *Hold monthly youth services advisory board meetings*
  - d. *Survey the youth quarterly to keep the programming current to their needs*
3. *Promote academic achievement and career development of community youth*
  - a. *Create, in partnership with the schools, a token economy system to reward students on the basis of achievement, attendance, and attitude on a quarterly basis.*
  - b. *Develop computer clubs and recruit trained professionals to advise the youth involved in them*
  - c. *Create partnerships with national and local business professionals*
  - d. *Develop youth operated businesses and apprenticeships*
4. *Expand personal family living service activities of the community youth*
  - a. *Facilitate quarterly workshops on intergenerational issues, home economics, decision-making, parenting, etc.*
  - b. *Develop clubs that promote learning activities, e.g. karate, carpentry, chess, etc.*
  - c. *Provide family/nurturing activities particularly for those youth who have no traditional family structure. E.g. holiday meals together, retreats, etc.*
